Control Requirements

HEEL :

The handler is required to walk his/ her dog on a loose lead from the start line to the 15m sit marker.

SIT :

The handler is required to sit the dog at the 15m marker with one command, remove the lead and return to the start line without the dog.

STAY :

The dog must remain seated for 30 seconds. The handler is permitted to give the dog one 'stay' reminder either before returning to the start line, or from the start line if he/ she wishes to do so.

RETURN :

The handler will return to the dog, replace the lead and heel the dog to the start line without undue delay and fuss.

WHISTLE WORK :

Whilst the dog is walking to heel on lead, the handler will demonstrate the dogs ability to sit on the whistle

Retrieving Requirements

RETRIEVE 1 :

A single marked retrieve on land and in clear view at 15m, thrown by the handler.

(HPRs & Retriever distance – 20m)

RETRIEVE 2 :

A single marked retrieve on land and in clear view at 20m, thrown by a helper.

(HPRs & Retriever distance – 30m)

MEMORY RETRIEVE :

The dog is walked to heel in a straight line from the start to the 15m marker, a dummy is dropped and the dog and handler walk back to the start line. The dog is then sent for the retrieve.

(HPRs & Retriever distance – 20m)

Hunting Requirements

HPRs & SPANIELS :

Will be required to demonstrate a desire for hunting away from the handler in light cover. The handler will demonstrate use of the turn whistle with the dog responding accordingly whilst hunting in an organised pattern.

RETRIEVERS :

Will be walked to heel to an area of light cover and instructed to hunt for a blind retrieve. The dog must demonstrate the ability to hunt an area of fall.
