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Control Requirements—Off Lead

HEEL:

The handler is required to walk his/ her dog off lead from the start line to the 25m sit marker.

(Points will be lost for repeated commands or poor positioning of the dog)

SIT:

The handler is required to sit the dog at the 25m marker with one command and return to the start line without the dog. The dog must remain seated for **30 seconds**. At the judges request, the handler will return to collect the dog and walk the dog to heel back to the start line.

(Points will be lost if the dog moves and/ or if further commands are given)

RECALL:

The handler will walk the dog to heel to the 25m marker and sit the dog. The handler will return to the start line and recall the dog using a whistle. The dog must return to the handler directly and without delay or excessive commands from the handler and be under control on arrival.

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Retrieving Requirements

RETRIEVE 1:

A single marked retrieve on land within an enclosed area. The dog must enter a pen either under or going over the fence, make the retrieve and return to the handler. The pen is located approx. 20m away from the handler.

RETRIEVE 2:

A single marked retrieve on land and in short cover at 25m.

MEMORY RETRIEVE:

The handler walks the dog at heel from the start line to the 25m marker. The handler drops the dummy, which the dog must mark, and then walk the dog at heel to the 10m marker and sit the dog. The handler must then direct the dog to 'go back' and make the retrieve.

DIRECTION:

The dog will be placed with his back against a fence or similar, with the handler approx. 3m away, facing the dog. Two dummies will be thrown, one either side of the dog at a distance of 20m. The dog will be instructed to retrieve the first thrown dummy with a hand signal by the handler. Once the dog has made the first retrieve and been placed back in the original sit position, the handler must retrieve the last thrown dummy themselves and pass it to the judge.

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Hunting Requirements

HPRs & SPANIELS:

Will be expected to move away from the handler and hunt the ground with purpose, style and pace and to be prompt on the turn whistle. The dog is also expected to sit instantly on the stop whistle whilst hunting.

RETRIEVERS:

Will be walked to heel and sent into an area of light cover, approx. 3m away from the handler and instructed to hunt for a blind retrieve. The dog must demonstrate the ability to hunt an area of fall away from the handler.



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
